Summary

The Title 1 teacher promotes and develops successful reading and math instruction for students and performs related duties in accordance with school policies.

The Title 1 teacher is responsible for group and individual instruction of reading and/or math for students who meet state and federal guidelines. The Title 1 teacher measures student progress.

Responsibilities and Duties

- Assist in the planning and development of the Title I Reading and Math program or other targeted areas of need the school is addressing.
- Identify students eligible for program's academic interventions
- Coordinate and provide strategic academic instruction to meet the individual needs of students especially in reading and math
- Assist student support team in analyzing and determining the academic needs specific student population
- Assist teachers in the use of assessment data to guide and differentiate instruction
- Serve as a resource for the staff, teachers, and parents in the selection of instructional supplies, materials, etc. for the eligible Title I students
- Maintain and update student achievement data using various screenings
- Coordinate and attend all Title I parent activities, including the required annual meetings, annual review, and parent workshops.
- Prepare lessons and teach Title I eligible students in small groups and through co-teaching with classroom teachers
- Provide communication to teachers regarding students' academic progress
- Other duties as assigned by the Director or Assistant Principal
