GUIDELINES:

Infinity Charter School ('Charter School") shall not discriminate against any person on the basis of race, sex, color, religion, sexual orientation, national origin, disability, genetic information or any other classification otherwise protected by applicable state and/or federal laws. Charter School's Board of Trustees recognizes school administrators' and employees' obligations to comply with all applicable federal, state and local laws in providing equal opportunity to all Charter School students. Code §12.4 and consistent with the Pennsylvania Human Relations Act (43 P.S. §§ 951 - 963), Charter School does not discriminate on the basis of race, sex, color, religion, sexual orientation, national origin, disability, genetic information or any other classification otherwise protected by law in the administration of its educational policies, admission policies, hiring policies, scholarship and aid programs, and other to a free and full public education, nor may a student be subject to disciplinary action on account of race, sex, color, religion, sexual orientation, national origin or disability.
